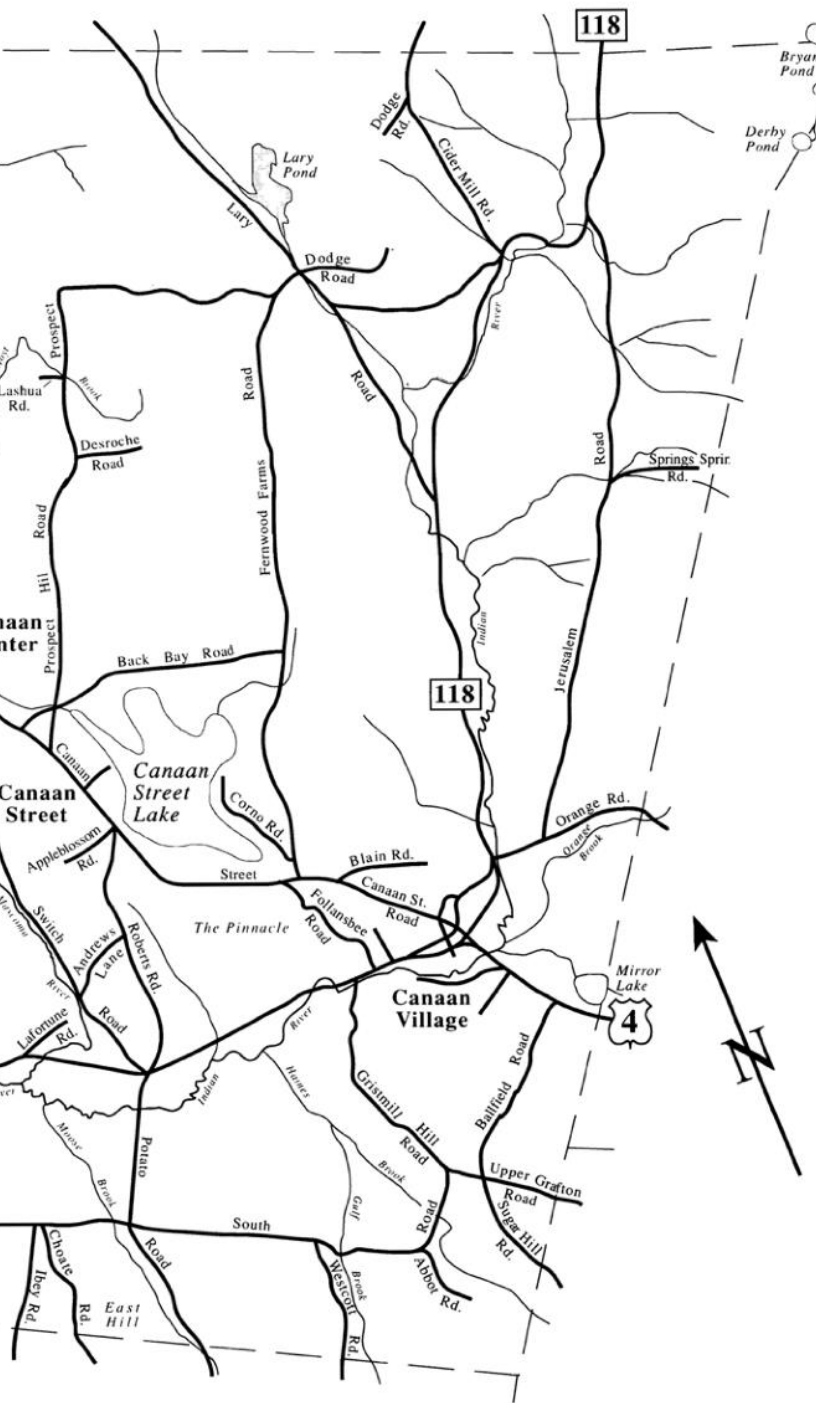

Mascoma Community Health Center is a community owned and operated, non-profit medical center for physical, behavioral, and dental health. The Center is directly accountable for quality of care to the residents it serves. Dedicated to keeping healthcare affordable, Mascoma Community Health Center serves everyone, regardless of ability to pay and accepts nearly any insurance coverage. Though community based, it is open to anyone, from anywhere.

## **What services are offered?**

Primary Medical Care for all ages, Family Practice, Pediatrics, Sports Medicine, Minor Orthopedics, Geriatric Care, Infants and Children, Women's Health Care, General Gynecology, Minor Skin Procedures, Dental Care, Behavioral/Mental Health Care, Physical Therapy\*, X-ray\*, Preventive Health/ Screenings, Care Coordination, Nutrition Services\*, Pharmacy\*, Health Education and Community Outreach. \*These services will soon be available.

## **What are the hours of operation?**

The Health Center is open Monday through Friday from 8 am to 5 pm and until 7 pm on Tuesdays. Hours will expand as we grow.

## **Can I use my insurance?**

Yes. Medicare, Medicaid, and most insurance policies accepted.

## **What if I have no insurance?**

The Health Center will help you find affordable insurance. It will also accept private payments and offer discounts for those in need.

**Geography:** Canaan, NH, latitude 43.4N, 72.3W, is located in the southern part of Grafton County. It is bounded by Dorchester on the north, Orange and Grafton on the east, Enfield and Grafton on the south, and Hanover on the west. The 2010 census records Canaan's population as 3, 909. Its 53.2 square miles are mostly forested with a mix of deciduous and coniferous trees. Land surface is uneven with many hills and valleys. The Mascoma River, its largest stream, has its source in the northwestern part of Dorchester. Other bodies of water are Canaan Street Lake, Clark Pond, Mud Pond, Bear Pond, Lary Pond, Goose Pond, and Little Goose Pond. Canaan has a northern, four-season climate.

**History:** Some dates of import:

1761 Canaan is incorporated as a town.

1834 Noyes Academy, a co-ed, inter-racial school is chartered but destroyed August 10, 1835 by angry local residents.

1923 The Great Fire destroys the Village.

2002 & 2004 Voters approve, respectively, a Transportation Enhancement Project and repair of the Canaan Town Library.

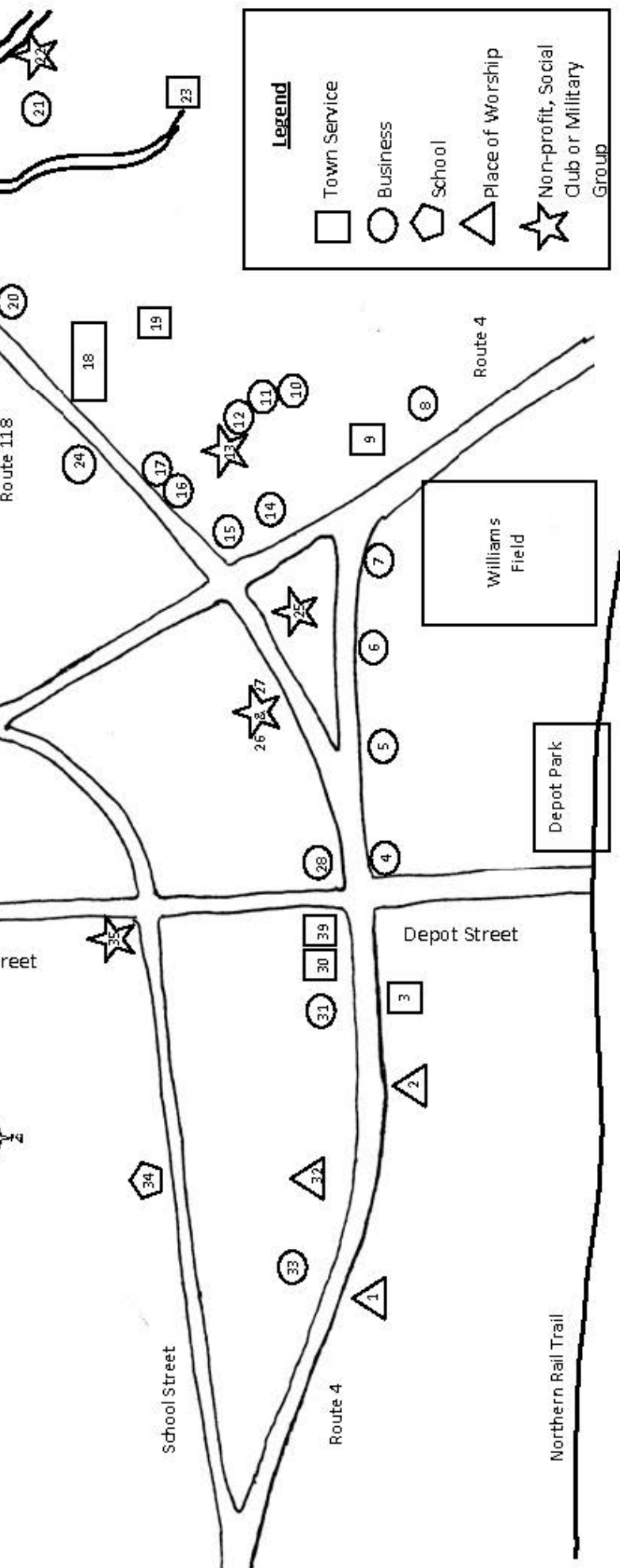

Property Taxes: Two payments per year; 1st payment (estimate) usually lower than 2<sup>nd</sup> payment.

Voter Registration, Checklist, Voting Locations  
Register during office hours at the Town Offices (except 10 days prior to election) or at voting locations on Election Day. Complete (name, address, place & date of birth, proof of citizenship) and sign application. If qualifications to vote are met, Supervisors of the Checklist will add the applicant to the voter checklist. Voting locations (polling places) are always posted at the Town Office and announced online.

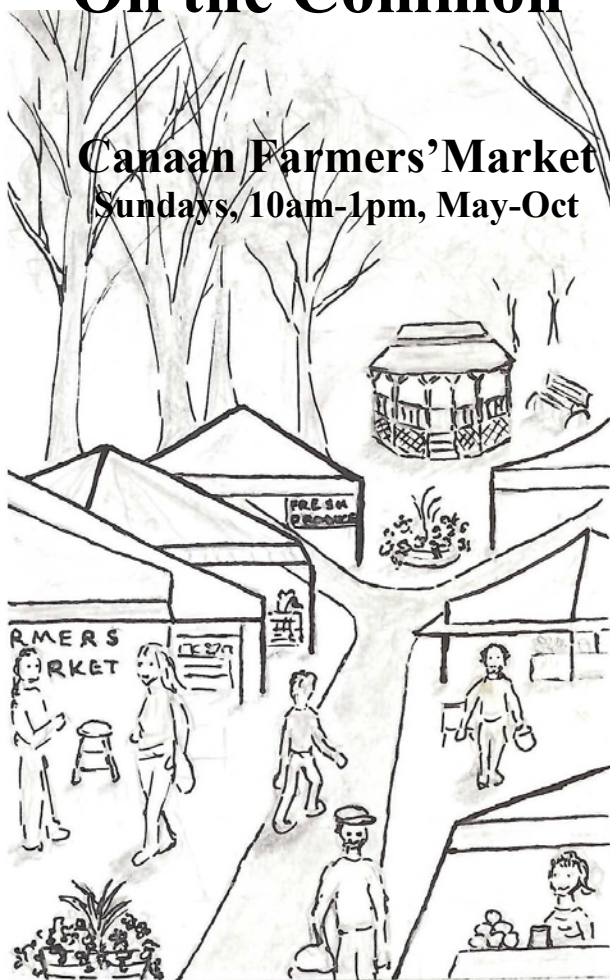

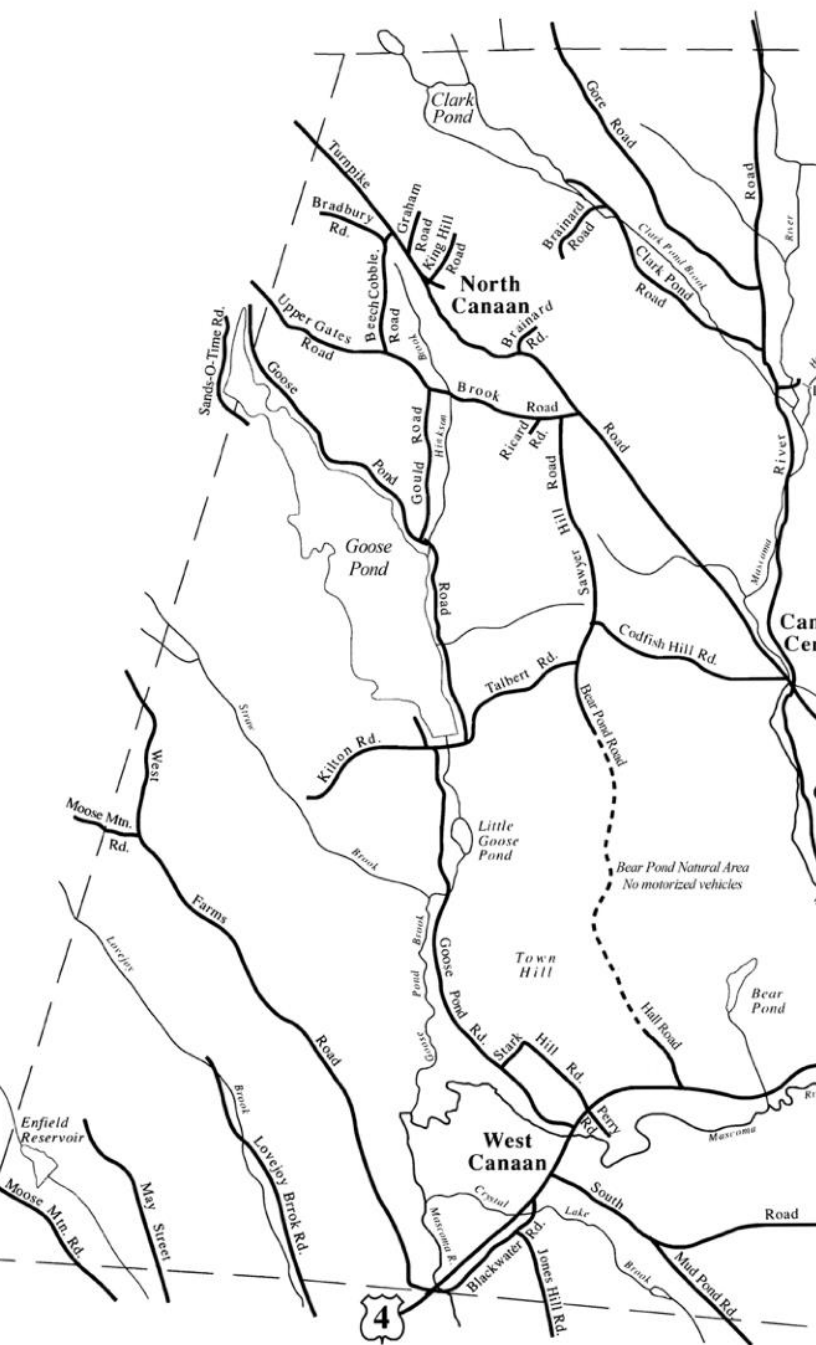
